A Brand New Day

Materials

Green ombré - 7/8 yard Blue ombré - 1/2 yard Brown ombré - 1/3 yard Backing - 1 5/8 yard Binding (scene fabric) - 3/8 yard Brown print - 1/2 yard Light green print - 1/4 yard Dark green print - 1/4 yard Scene fabric - 5/8 yard

- 1. Cut 1 6" strip brown print. Cut the following increments across strip $\frac{6 \frac{1}{2}$ ", $\frac{5 \frac{1}{2}$ ", $\frac{5 \frac{1}{2}$ ", $\frac{5 \frac{1}{2}$ ", $\frac{5 \frac{1}{2}}{2}$ ", $\frac{5 \frac{1}{2}}{2}$ ", $\frac{5 \frac{1}{2}}{2}$ ". Stack face down in order.
- 2. Cut 2 1 ½" strips green ombré. Cut into 10 6" strips. Stack face down with darks on the bottom and lights on top.
- 3. Align a dark green ombré strip on the right edge of a 6 ½" brown print, right sides together. Sew together with a ¼" s.a. Open out pieces and finger press seam toward green. Place a 5 ½" brown print on right edge of green ombré and sew. Continue this process, making the strip unit shown below. Press.



- 4. Cut this strip unit into 3 1 ½" strips, being careful to <u>align one of the lines of the ruler with the seam lines to make sure cuts are exactly perpendicular to seam lines</u>. Set aside.
- 5. Cut a 13" piece of green ombré across width. Beginning on the light side of the fabric, cut the following increments 6 ½", 5 ½", 5", 4", 3 ½", 3 ¼", 3", 2 ¾", 2 ½", 2 ½", 2 ½". 2". Stack them in order face down.
- 6. Cut 4 1 ½" brown print strips. Cut into 10 13" strips.
- 7. Place 6 ½" light green ombré and a brown strip right sides together and sew along right edge. Continue sewing pieces together following same procedure as in step 3 above. Carefully press toward green.
- 8. Cut into 6 2" strips units. Take the strip unit made in step 4 and sew one between two of the units you just made. Make 3 strip units as shown below.



- 9. Cut 1 9" piece of blue ombré across width of fabric. Cut into underlined increments listed in step1.
- 10. Cut 3 1 ½" strips green print. Cut into 10 9" pieces.
- 11. Repeat same process as above to make 2 strip units as shown below.



- 12. Cut 1 17" strip scene fabric across width of fabric. From top of scene, cut an 18" piece.
- 13. Cut 2 1 1/2" brown strips. Cut into 3 17" pieces.
- 14. Sew a brown strip to bottom edge of 18"x 17" piece of scene fabric. Press toward scene fabric.
- 15. From the next section down, cut a 15 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 17" piece. Sew a 17" brown print piece to bottom edge. Sew this unit to the unit made in step 14.
- 16. From next section of fabric, cut a 5 3/4" x 17" piece. Sew a 17" brown print piece to bottom edge. Sew this to the units made in step 154.
- 17. From next section, cut a 4 3/4" x 17" piece. Sew this to the previously sewn unit. Press.
- 18. Beginning on the left, cut 6 2 ½" strips from scene unit. Stack face down in order.



- 19. Referring to quilt photo, pin and sew each strip unit together. Carefully press. Trim top to square.
- 20. Cut 1 5" strip EACH blue ombré and green print for top and bottom borders.
- 21. Cut 2 5" strips <u>EACH</u> green and brown ombrés across width of fabric. Matching the colors, sew a strip about 60" long for the right and left borders. Sew on borders, mitering the corners.
- 22. Cut 5 2 ½" strips scene fabric for binding. Sew short ends together. Fold and press lengthwise. Stitch to finished quilt and turn to back. Sew in place with a blind stitch.
