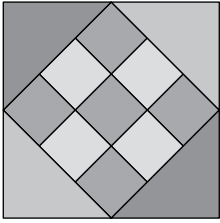

**FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 11 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 11 $\frac{5}{8}$ " • FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 61"**

- *Separate materials and cutting lists are given for each of the two quilts.*
  - *Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.*
- 

### **Materials: Blue/Yellow Quilt**

- 1 $\frac{1}{8}$  yds. Blue Medallion (6AB1) for blocks and binding
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Large Yellow Floral (2AB2) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Yellow Medallion (6AB2) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. Small Blue Floral (5AB1) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Small Yellow Floral Bouquet (4AB2) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. Large Yellow Floral Bouquet (1AB2) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Small Blue Floral Bouquet (4AB1) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. Small Green Sprigs (7AB3) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Small Blue Sprigs (7AB1) for blocks
- 1 $\frac{2}{3}$  yds. Blue Trellis Stripe (3AB1) for inner border
- 1 $\frac{2}{3}$  yds. Large Blue Floral Bouquet (1AB1) for outer border
- 3 $\frac{3}{8}$  yds. for backing (widthwise seam)

### **Materials: Green/Pink Quilt**

- 1 $\frac{1}{8}$  yds. Green Medallion (6AB3) for blocks and binding
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Large Pink Floral (2AB3) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Pink Medallion (6AB4) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Small Yellow Floral Bouquet (4AB2) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Small Pink Floral (5AB2) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Large Pink Floral Bouquet (1AB4) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Small Green Floral (5AB3) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Small Green Floral Bouquet (4AB3) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Small Pink Sprigs (7AB2) for blocks
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yd. Small Green Sprigs (7AB3) for blocks
- 1 $\frac{2}{3}$  yds. Pink Trellis Stripe (3AB2) for inner border
- 1 $\frac{2}{3}$  yds. Large Green Floral Bouquet (1AB3) for outer border
- 3 $\frac{3}{8}$  yds. for backing (widthwise seam)

### **Cutting: Blue/Yellow Quilt**

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

*From Blue Medallion, cut in order given:*

- 6 strips, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40", for double-fold binding
- 60 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", for blocks

*From Large Yellow Floral, Yellow Medallion, Small Blue Floral, Small Yellow Floral Bouquet, Large Yellow Floral Bouquet, Small Blue Floral Bouquet, Small Green Sprigs, and Small Blue Sprigs, cut a total of:*

- 48 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", for blocks (You will need 4 matching squares for each block.)
- 24 squares, 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ "; cut each square once diagonally to make 48 triangles for blocks

*From Blue Trellis Stripe, cut:*

- 4 strips, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x length of fabric, for inner border  
(*Note: Cut border strips so that the design repeat is the same in each strip; this will make the design match at the mitered corners.*)

*From Large Blue Floral Bouquet, cut:*

- 4 strips, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x length of fabric, for outer border  
(Strips are cut long and will be trimmed to size later.)

### **Cutting: Green/Pink Quilt**

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

*From Green Medallion, cut in order given:*

- 6 strips, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40", for double-fold binding
- 60 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", for blocks

*From Large Pink Floral, Pink Medallion, Small Yellow Floral Bouquet, Small Pink Floral, Large Pink Floral Bouquet, Small Green Floral, Small Green Floral Bouquet, Small Pink Sprigs, and Small Green Sprigs, cut a total of:*

- 48 squares, 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", for blocks (You will need 4 matching squares for each block.)
- 24 squares, 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ "; cut each square once diagonally to make 48 triangles for blocks

*From Pink Trellis Stripe, cut:*

- 4 strips, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x length of fabric, for inner border  
(*Note: Cut border strips so that the design repeat is the same in each strip; this will make the design match at the mitered corners.*)

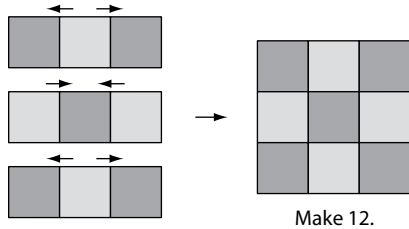
*From Large Green Floral Bouquet, cut:*

- 4 strips, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x length of fabric, for outer border  
(Strips are cut long and will be trimmed to size later.)

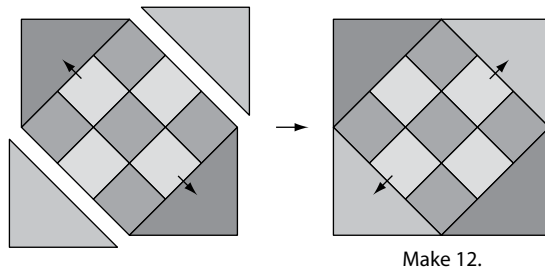
## Assembly

All seams  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Assembly instructions are the same for both quilts. Refer to photographs for fabric placement.

1. Using 5 Blue Medallion or Green Medallion  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, and 4 matching assorted-print  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, assemble 1 ninepatch as shown. Repeat to make a total of 12 ninepatches.



2. Sew 2 matching assorted-print triangles to opposite sides of a ninepatch. Then, selecting a different print, sew 2 matching triangles to remaining 2 sides of ninepatch. Repeat to make a total of 12 blocks.



3. Sew blocks together in horizontal rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram at right. Press for opposing seams from row to row. Then sew rows together. Press seams in one direction.

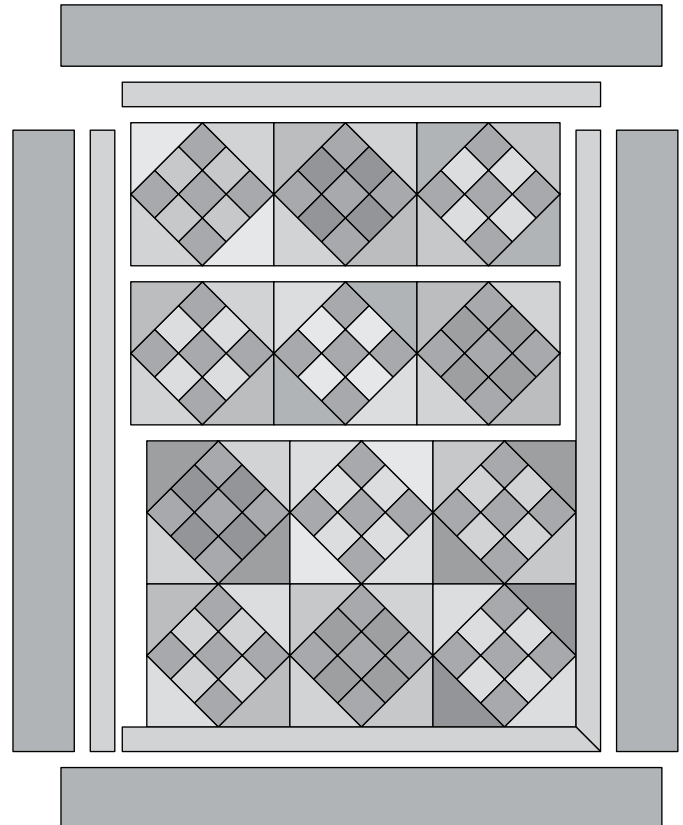
## Borders

1. With right sides together, center and sew inner border strips to sides of quilt, stopping and backstitching  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from edges. Press seams toward borders. The borders will extend beyond the top and bottom of your quilt top. Now sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt; start and stop your seams at the point where the side borders join the quilt top. Miter corners using your favorite technique.
2. Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim 2 outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.

3. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim 2 remaining outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.

## Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
