



Cutting

(All strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.)

For the Twin Size Bed Quilt

From the green leaves, cut:

(2) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " strips. Recut into (24) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the lavender leaves, cut:

(7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the inner border.

From the violet dot, cut:

(3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (48) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the purple dot, cut:

(3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (48) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

(9) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips for the binding.

From the blue paisley, cut:

(16) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (96) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.

From the violet paisley, cut:

(12) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut (6) strips into (48) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces. Recut (6) strips into (96) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the pale lilac, cut:

(6) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (48) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

(2) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " strips. Recut into (24) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the large floral, cut:

(8) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the outer border.

From the green floral, cut:

(6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (96) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the violet floral, cut:

(12) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (192) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

For the Wall Hanging/Table Topper

From the green leaves, cut:

(2) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " strips. Recut into (16) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the lavender leaves, cut:

(6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the inner border.

From the violet dot, cut:

(2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (32) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the purple dot, cut:

(2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (32) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

(7) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips for the binding.

From the blue paisley, cut:

(11) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (64) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.

From the violet paisley, cut:

(8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut (4) strips into (32) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces. Recut (4) strips into (64) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the pale lilac, cut:

(4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (32) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

(2) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " strips. Recut into (16) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

From the large floral, cut:

(7) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the outer border.

From the green floral, cut:

(4) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (64) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the violet floral, cut:


(8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Recut into (128) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Sewing


(All seams are sewn with right sides together, raw edges even and using 1/4" seam allowance.)

Making the Block Centers


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " violet paisley square. Layer the marked square in a corner of a 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pale lilac square, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam line and press the resulting violet triangle up to make the unit shown. Repeat to make a second unit.




2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " pale lilac square. Layer the marked square with a 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " green leaves square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" away on both sides of the marked line. Cut the unit apart on the marked line to make (2) pieced squares as shown.



3. Stitch a pieced square from step 2 to a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " violet paisley square, noting orientation. Sew this unit to a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " violet paisley piece to make a corner unit. Repeat to make a second unit.




4. Sew the corner units from step 3 to the pale lilac units from step 1, noting orientation, to yield an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " block center unit.



Block Assembly

1. Draw diagonal lines on the wrong sides of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " green floral and violet floral squares. Layer the marked squares on the ends of a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blue paisley piece, as shown below, noting orientation of the marked lines. Sew on the marked lines. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam lines and press the resulting triangles up to make the unit shown. Stitch a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " violet floral square to the left-hand side of the blue paisley unit. Repeat to make a second unit.





Block Assembly (cont.)

2. Draw diagonal lines on the wrong sides of 2 ½" green floral and violet floral squares. Layer the marked squares on the ends of a 2 ½" x 6 ½" blue paisley piece, as shown below, noting orientation of the marked lines. Sew on the marked lines. Trim ¼" beyond the seam lines and press the resulting triangles up to make the unit shown. *Please note that this unit is a mirror image of the units made in step 1.* Stitch a 2 ½" violet floral square to the right-hand side of the blue paisley unit. Repeat to make a second unit. Sew a 2 ½" violet dot square to the left-hand side of each blue paisley unit. Sew a 2 ½" purple dot square to the right-hand side of each unit.



3. Stitch the blue paisley units from step 1 to the left and right sides of the Block Center unit, noting orientation of both the blue paisley patches and the block center. Sew the blue paisley units from step 2 to the top and bottom of the block center, again noting orientation of the blue paisley patches.



Quilt Assembly

For the Twin Size Bed Quilt

1. Repeat the steps in the Making the Block Centers and Block Assembly sections to make a total of (24) identical blocks.
2. Arrange the blocks into (6) rows with (4) blocks in each row. Rotate the individual blocks as necessary to create the secondary design, using the quilt pictured on the cover as a guide. Sew the blocks into rows and sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.
3. Trim the selvages from the 2 ½" purple leaves strips and sew the strips together end to end to make a long 2 ½" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 72 ½" and (2) 52 ½" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Sew the longer pieces to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the shorter pieces to the top and bottom.
4. Trim the selvages from the 9 ½" large floral strips and sew the strips together end to end to make a long 9 ½" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 76 ½" and (2) 70 ½" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Sew the longer pieces to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the shorter pieces to the top and bottom.
5. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.
6. Trim the finished quilt and bind using the 2 ¼" purple dot strips.

For the Wall Hanging/Table Topper

1. Repeat the steps in the Making the Block Centers and Block Assembly sections to make a total of (16) identical blocks.
2. Arrange the blocks into (4) rows with (4) blocks in each row. Rotate the individual blocks as necessary to create the secondary design, using the quilt pictured on the cover as a guide. Sew the blocks into rows and sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.
3. Trim the selvages from the 2 ½" purple leaves strips and sew the strips together end to end to make a long 2 ½" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 52 ½" and (2) 48 ½" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Sew the shorter pieces to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the longer pieces to the top and bottom.
4. Trim the selvages from the 6 ½" large floral strips and sew the strips together end to end to make a long 6 ½" strip. From this long strip, cut (2) 64 ½" and (2) 52 ½" lengths (*if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top*). Sew the shorter pieces to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew the longer pieces to the top and bottom.
5. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.
6. Trim the finished quilt and bind using the 2 ¼" purple dot strips.
