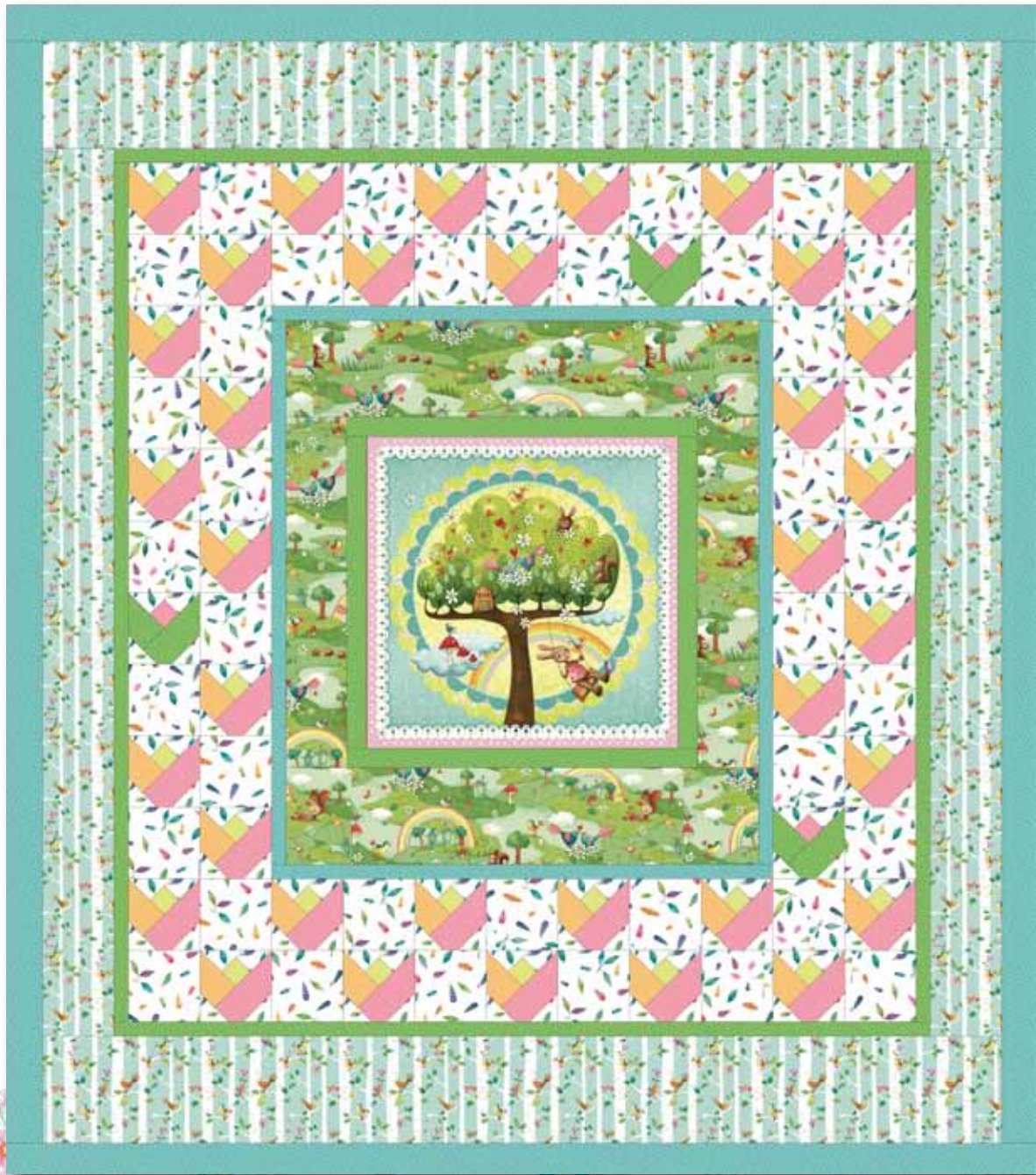


Rainbow Woodland

Quilt size: approximately 72" x 82"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Yardages are based on 40" wide, unwashed fabric.

A. Pattern #25884 – MUL1	1 panel
B. Pattern #25885 – MUL1	7/8 yard
C. Pattern #25887 – MUL1	1 7/8 yards
D. Pattern #25889 – BLU1	2 yards
E. Pattern #25890 – BLU1	1 5/8 yards
F. Pattern #25890 – LTGRE1	1/4 yard
G. Pattern #25890 – MDGRE1	7/8 yard
H. Pattern #25890 – MDPIN1	5/8 yard
I. Pattern #25890 – ORA1	1/2 yard
Backing (Pattern #25885 – MUL1 suggested)	5 1/8 yards
Batting	80" x 90"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. 1/4" seam allowance is included in measurements and all strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless noted otherwise. Label pieces and keep together until ready to sew. These instructions are based on unwashed fabrics. WOF = width of fabric. LOF = length of fabric, parallel to selvege.

A. Pattern #25884 – MUL1 (panel):

1. Fussy cut main panel block 1/4" beyond outer edges to approximately 21 1/4" square.

B. Pattern #25885 – MUL1 (scenic):

1. Cut two 4 1/2" x 25 1/2" LOF border strips.
2. Cut three 7" x remaining WOF border strips.

C. Pattern #25887 – MUL1 (leaves):

1. Cut six 5 1/2" strips. Sub-cut thirty-eight 5 1/2" squares and two 4 1/4" squares.

2. Cut one 4 1/4" strip. Sub-cut eight 4 1/4" squares. Cut these squares and the two from step 1 in half diagonally twice to make forty triangles. Discard two.
3. Cut four 3 1/2" strips. Sub-cut thirty-eight 3 1/2" squares and eleven 2" x 3" pieces. Cut the 3 1/2" squares in half diagonally to make seventy-six triangles.
4. Cut two 3" strips. Sub-cut twenty-seven 2" x 3" pieces.

D. Pattern #25889 – BLU1 (trees):

1. Cut two 5 1/2" x 62 1/2" LOF border strips.
2. Cut five 8" x remaining WOF border strips.

E. Pattern #25890 – BLU1 (texture):

1. Cut eight 3" border strips.
2. Cut eight 2 1/2" strips for binding.
3. Cut four 1 1/2" strips. Sub-cut two 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" and two 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" border strips.

F. Pattern #25890 – LTGRE1 (texture):

1. Cut two 2" strips. Sub-cut thirty-five 2" squares.

G. Pattern #25890 – MDGRE1 (texture):

1. Cut one 2 5/8" strip. Sub-cut three 2 5/8" x 6 1/2" and three 2 5/8" x 4 1/4" pieces.
2. Cut four 3" strips. Sub-cut two 3" x 22" and two 3" x 26 1/2" framing strips.
3. Cut six 1 1/2" border strips.

H. Pattern #25890 – MDPIN1 (texture):

1. Cut six 2 3/8" strips. Sub-cut (35) 2 3/8" x 6 1/2" pieces and three 2" squares.

I. Pattern #25890 – ORA1 (texture):






1. Cut four 2 3/8" strips. Sub-cut (35) 2 3/8" x 4 1/4" pieces.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

A. Panel Block Assembly: (refer to quilt diagram)

1. Stitch 3" x 22" G strips to right and left sides of A panel. Press toward G. Trim strips even with top and bottom of panel. Add 3" x 26 1/2" G strips to top and bottom of panel. Press toward G. The G strips are wider than needed. Trim bordered panel to 25 1/2" square.
2. Sew 4 1/2" x 25 1/2" B borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Press toward B. Stitch three 7" x remaining WOF B strips together matching design as much as possible. Cut into two 33 1/2" borders. Add borders to top and bottom of bordered panel. Press toward B.
3. Sew 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" E strips to right and left sides of the bordered panel and 1 1/2" x 35 1/2" E strips to top and bottom. Press toward E.

B. Tulip Block Assembly:

1. Stitch a 2" F square to a 2" x 3" C piece. Press toward F. Add a 4 1/4" C triangle as shown (Figure 1). Press toward the triangle. 
2. Add a 2 3/8" x 4 1/4" I piece, then a 2 5/8" x 6 1/2" H piece as shown (Figure 2). Press toward H and I. 
3. Trim unit to 5 1/2" tall, first trimming even with edge of C triangle at top and then 5 1/2" down. (Figure 3). 
4. Sew two 3 1/2" C triangles to bottom as shown (Figure 4). Press toward the triangles. 
5. Trim Tulip block to 5 1/2" square (Figure 5). 

6. Make a total of 35 pink/orange Tulip blocks (Figure 6).

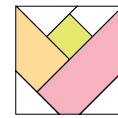

7. In the same manner, make three green Tulip blocks (Figure 7).

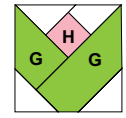

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

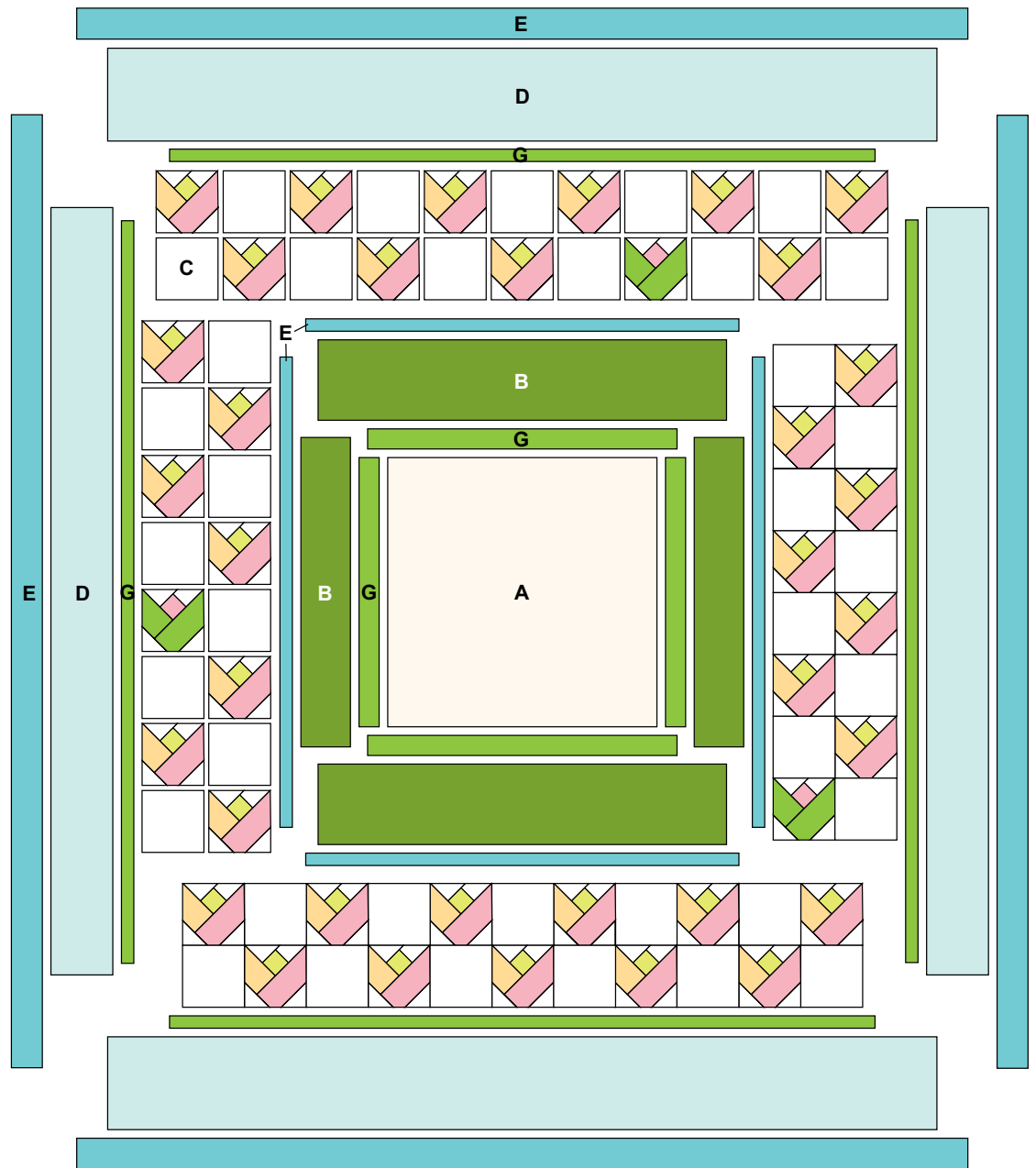
(refer to quilt photo and diagram)

1. Arrange seven pink/orange Tulip blocks, one green Tulip block and eight 5 1/2" C squares for both right and left sides of quilt center. Sew blocks and squares into eight vertical rows on each side. Press toward C squares. Sew vertical rows together to make two 10 1/2" x 40 1/2" sections. Press to one side. Sew to sides of quilt center. Press toward quilt center.
2. Arrange ten pink/orange Tulip blocks, one green Tulip block and eleven 5 1/2" C squares for top of quilt center. Sew blocks and squares into two horizontal rows. Press toward C squares. Sew rows together to make 10 1/2" x 55 1/2" top section. Press seam to one side. Stitch to top of quilt center. Press toward top section.
3. Arrange eleven pink/orange Tulip blocks and eleven 5 1/2" C squares for bottom of quilt center. Sew blocks and squares into two horizontal rows. Press toward C squares. Sew rows together to make the 10 1/2" x 55 1/2" bottom section. Press seam to one side. Stitch to bottom of quilt center. Press seam toward bottom section.
4. Sew 1 1/2" G strips together end to end. Press seams open. Cut two 60 1/2" and two 57 1/2" strips. Sew the longer strips to the right and left sides of the quilt center and the shorter strips to the top and bottom. Press toward G.
5. Stitch 5 1/2" x 62 1/2" D borders to right and left sides of quilt. Press toward D. Sew five 8" x remaining WOF D strips together end to end matching design as much as possible. Press seams open. Cut into two 67 1/2" strips. Sew borders to top and bottom of quilt. Press toward D.
6. Sew 3" E strips together end to end. Press seams open. Cut two 77 1/2" strips and two 72 1/2" strips. Sew the longer strips to the right and left

sides of the quilt center and the shorter strips to the top and bottom. Press toward E.

FINISHING:

1. Prepare backing with a vertical seam to measure 80" x 90".
2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with top.
5. Join eight 2½" E binding strips together with diagonal seams. Attach to quilt using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to back of the quilt.
