

	C Mini Floral 3663-33 <i>Gold</i>	2/3 yd	(2) 4-1/4" x WOF, sub-cut (10) 4-1/4" x 4-1/4". Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) triangles. (3) 3-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (13) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2"
	D Pear Dot 6049-12 <i>Black</i>	3/4 yd	(3) 4-1/4" x WOF, sub-cut (20) 4-1/4" x 4-1/4". Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (80) triangles. (2) 3-7/8" x WOF, sub-cut (20) 3-7/8" x 3-7/8"
	E Basket Weave 6051-77 <i>Chocolate</i>	2/3 yd	(2) 4-1/4" x WOF, sub-cut (10) 4-1/4" x 4-1/4". Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) triangles. (4) 2" x WOF, sub-cut (80) 2" x 2"
	F Folk Plaid 6050-44 <i>Dark Green</i>	1/3 yd	(2) 3-7/8" x WOF, sub-cut (20) 3-7/8" x 3-7/8"
	G Pollen 2867-71 <i>Linen</i>	1 yd	(2) 3-7/8" x WOF, sub-cut (20) 3-7/8" x 3-7/8" (2) 4-1/4" x WOF, sub-cut (10) 4-1/4" x 4-1/4". Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) triangles. (4) 3-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (80) 2" x 3-1/2"
	H Mini Floral 3663-44 <i>Green</i>	7/8 yd	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (20) 2" x 4-1/2" (1) 7-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (20) 2" x 7-1/2" (3) 3-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (13) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2"
	I Folk Plaid 6050-70 <i>Tan</i>	7/8 yd	(7) 3-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (84) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"

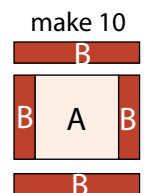

	J Folk Rooster 6047-40 <i>Sage</i>	1/2 yd	(3) 4-1/4" x WOF, sub-cut (20) 4-1/4" x 4-1/4". Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (80) triangles.
	K Folk Plaid 6050-07 <i>Linen</i>	1 yd	(2) 3-7/8" x WOF, sub-cut (20) 3-7/8" x 3-7/8" (2) 4-1/4" x WOF, sub-cut (10) 4-1/4" x 4-1/4". Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) triangles. (4) 3-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (80) 2" x 3-1/2"
	L Weathered Texture 6052-72 <i>Mocha</i>	1/2 yd	(7) 2" x WOF strips*
	M Mini Floral 3663-11 <i>Red</i>	1/2 yd	(2) 6-1/2" x WOF, sub-cut (14) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2"

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

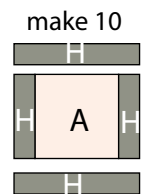
BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2' WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 4-1/2" **B** strip to each side of (1) 4-1/2" **A** panel. Sew (1) 2" x 7-1/2" **B** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** panel. Trim the block to 6-1/2" square to make (1) **AB-block**. Repeat to make (10) **AB-blocks** total.



2. Sew (1) 2" x 4-1/2" **H** strip to each side of (1) 4-1/2" **A** panel. Sew (1) 2" x 7-1/2" **H** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** panel. Trim the block to 6-1/2" square to make (1) **AH-block**. Repeat to make (10) **AH-blocks** total.



3. Place (1) 3-7/8" **G** square on top of (1) 3-7/8" **F** square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make (2) **FG** units. Trim the **FG** units to measure 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make (40) **FG** units total.

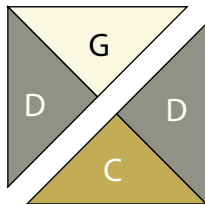
4. Repeat Step 3 using (20) 3-7/8" **D** squares and (20) 3-7/8" **K** squares to make (40) 3-1/2" **DK** units.

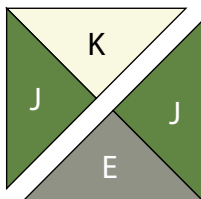
5. Sew (1) **C** triangle, (2) **D** triangles and (1) **G** triangle together to make (1) **DCG** unit. Repeat to make (40) **DCG** units total.

6. Sew (1) **E** triangle, (2) **J** triangles and (1) **K** triangle together to make (1) **JEK** unit. Repeat to make (40) **JEK** units total.

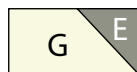


7. Place (1) 2" **E** square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3-1/2" **G** strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **EG** unit. Repeat to make (40) **EG** units total.



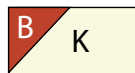
8. Place (1) 2" **E** square on the right side of (1) 2" x 3-1/2" **G** strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **GE** unit. Repeat to make (40) **GE** units total.

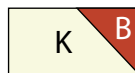
9. Repeat Step 7 using (40) 2" **B** squares and (40) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" **K** strips to make (40) **BK** units.

10. Repeat Step 8 using (40) 2" x 3-1/2" **K** strips and (40) 2" **B** squares to make (40) **KB** units.

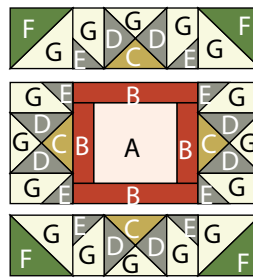


11. Sew (4) **FG** units, (4) **GE** units, (4) **EG** units, (4) **DCG** units and (1) **AB-block** together to make (1) **Block One**. Repeat to make (10) **Block Ones** total.

12. Sew (4) **DK** units, (4) **BK** units, (4) **KB** units, (4) **JEK** units and (1) **AH-block** together to make (1) **Block Two**. Repeat to make (10) **Block Twos** total.

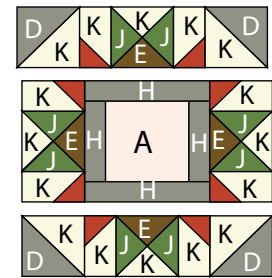

13. Place (1) 3 1/2" **I** square on the left side of (1) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" **M** strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



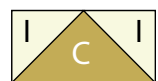
14. Place another 3-1/2" **I** square on the right side of the 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" **M** strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **IMI** unit.



15. Repeat Steps 13-14 to make (14) **IMI** units total.

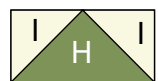
16. Repeat Steps 13-14 using (13) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" **C** strips and (26) 3-1/2" **I** squares to make (13) **ICI** units.

17. Repeat Steps 13-14 using (13) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" **H** strips and (26) 3-1/2" **I** squares to make (13) **IHI** units.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

18. Sew (2) **Block Ones** and (2) **Block Twos** together, alternating them, to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three** and **Row Five**.

19. Sew (2) **Block Twos** and (2) **Block Ones** together, alternating them, to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four**.

20. Sew the (5) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.

BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE L AND B BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

21. Sew (1) **L** 2" x (60-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) **L** 2" x (51-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.

22. Sew (1) **B** 2" x (63-1/2") strip to each sides of the quilt top. Sew **B** (1) 2" x (54-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

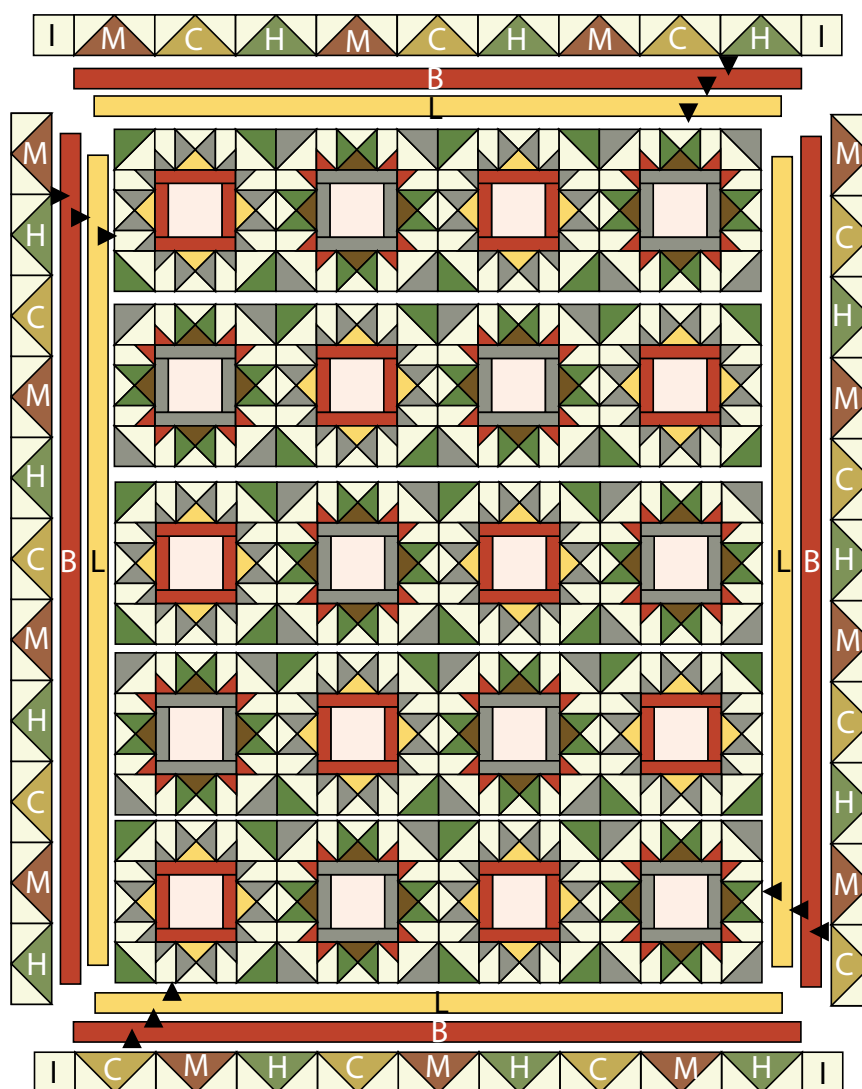
23. Sew (11) assorted **IMI** units, **ICI** units and **IHI** units together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the quilt top.

24. Sew (9) assorted **IMI** units, **ICI** units, **IHI** units and (2) 3 1/2" **I** squares together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
